At the recent Michigan Region meeting that I attended, election for three of the Regional officers was held. Two of the positions were filled as follows:

The third position was not filled and will remain open until someone volunteers to fill it. That position is the Region Secretary. The position isn't hard. To give you a basic idea on the requirements: you attend the regional meetings, take minutes, publish minutes to the Regional Governors, and send out notification of the meetings. The meetings are held on the Tuesday before the National Governor's Meeting, generally in February, April, September, November, and the Tuesday preceding the National Convention (usually June or July).
